In 2018 he released his first solo album in 15 years, "Skin & Bones" which was closely followed by 2019's all-original album "Keep Drinkin' That Coffee!", and the acoustic EP "Hot Nuts!"

# **Technical Requirements**

#### General

I am a solo singer, resonator ukulele and 5-string banjo player, playing blues, old-time, hokum and other early 20<sup>th</sup> century American folk music, plus original songs in the same style.

I perform acoustic music and do not use electronic pickups in my instruments, just microphones.

Unless specified, PA must be supplied by the venue/ promoter. It should be fit for purpose, safe, and set up and operated by someone qualified to do so. As this is acoustic music, I don't encourage venues to turn up to electric band levels or use effects (no reverb please), and the monitors should be set very low or off.

I can supply a compact PA suitable for small gigs.

# On Stage

1x vocal mic (pref. SM58) and 1x instrument mic (pref. SM57 or SM81), on boom stands 1x DI for percussion 'stomp box'

1x armless chair

## Other requirements

Drinking water should be available backstage. If a meal is being provided, please note that I am vegetarian.
